ICT Subgroup

The aim of the **Rotherham Lifelong Learning Partnership (RLLP)** is “**to stimulate a culture of learning and development to ensure maximum benefit for local people and businesses.**” The ICT Sub Group apply that aim to the more specific field of using e-Learning and IT in teaching and Learning.

The website, www.learninginrotherham.org.uk, was developed in 2004, initially as a vehicle to make public the work of the RLLP ICT Subgroup. Therefore the site has hosted the regularly updated ICT Strategies and Action Plans, information about RLLP breakthrough projects and the pilot phase of the Rotherham Connected Community Project.

In line with the development of the work of RLLP and the ICT subgroup the website has developed to reflect the work and needs of the partnership as a whole:

The current aims of www.learninginrotherham.org.uk are:

- To make transparent the work of the ICT subgroup and the RLLP
- To provide a one-stop-shop of resources for education practitioners in Rotherham
- To provide a showcase for ICT based learning activities and successes in Rotherham

The most recent developments on the site have focussed on the second aim specifically in the field of Adult Community Learning (ACL). The ACL section of the site contains national, regional and local resources such as PDFs, links and subject specific learning materials shared by the Rotherham E-Guides and is a model for the next stages which will cover 14-19 and the Language Strategy.

In addition the Members section of the site is an area in which resources can be securely shared. The members section has been working for the ICT subgroup for the previous year and the Rotherham Adult Learning Partnership is the next in line for development.

The ongoing work of the website is to remain a central point of reference, information and communication for people working in Rotherham to develop education, ICT and e-learning.
